The following statement and CODE of CONDUCT shall apply to all summer workshop participants, The First Presbyterian Church Youth Development Program (FPCYDP) will adhere to the CODE of CONDUCT as outlined below.

NOTE: Violations of any aspect of the CODE of CONDUCT will be immediately reported to the FPCYDP Immediate corrective action will be taken with further disciplinary action to follow upon detailed investigation of the infraction or incident.

Code of Conduct

1. The health, safety, and welfare of others must be respected at all times.
2. Appropriate language and behavior are expected at all times. Profanity, foul or abusive language, inflammatory statements, derogatory comments or physical altercations toward any group or individual are not permitted.
3. Participants are expected to participate in all scheduled workshop activities.
4. Participants are responsible for following the instructions of all Summer Workshop staff and event volunteer leaders.
5. All behavior or language of a sexual nature at events is inappropriate and unacceptable. Dignified and respectable behavior is expected at all times from children, youth and adults.
6. Behavior during free time is subject to the supervision of summer workshop staff.
7. Dress code standards set for the event must be met by all participants (i.e., no sexually suggestive, culturally insensitive, tobacco or alcohol industry sponsored shirts, inappropriately cut shirts, shorts, pants or skirts, etc.).
8. Possession, distribution, or use of alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is prohibited. Prescription drugs and over-the-counter medications may be dispensed by adult chaperones only with written authorization provided by the parent/guardian
9. With the well being of self and others smoking and the use of other tobacco products is prohibited.
10. Care and respect for property, personal and institutional, is expected at all times. Theft, possession of missing property is prohibited.
11. Unauthorized possession, distribution or use fireworks are prohibited.
12. Honesty is expected at all times from summer workshop members. Dishonesty, cheating, plagiarism and forgery are inappropriate actions.
